Qualifications for Applicant

Selection criteria:

A. Applicant must be an admitted, degree-seeking Longwood University MBA student, currently enrolled in the program. Award money will be applied directly to the student's account. Applicant must demonstrate a commitment to leadership.

Application and Selection Process

Applicant must:

* Demonstrate via a written essay how the student has demonstrated leadership skills in their workplace/school, family, and/or community. This essay is **limited to 500 words** and must be submitted in double-spaced format.

* Submit a minimum of one and not more than three supporting letters of recommendation. These can be from school personnel or personal contacts. Letters of recommendation should be emailed to: barrettdt@longwood.edu

Selection of the scholarship recipient will be based on the individual's personal involvements and commitment to leadership. This can include, but is not limited to, demonstration of how he or she has developed and/or designed leadership projects; implemented an action to display leadership skills; enhanced or improved an existing situation or service; or other ways of being a role-model for leadership. Project or service could be of short-term or long-term duration. The student should explain in his/her essay how he/she believes that circumstances have been improved by their personal actions and commitment.

Award money will be applied directly to student account.
